

Nevada Princess 2012 People's Choice Voting Rules

1. Voters will vote for their "People's Choice" selection based upon the 2012 pageant contestants listed on the official website.
2. Online voting will begin Wednesday, January 18, 2012 at 8:00 AM (PT). Online voting will end on Friday, February 24, 2012 at 12:00 PM (PT).
3. Online voting is open to anyone that is at least 16 years of age and has the ability to make payment through a Pay Pal account.
4. Voting will also take place on Sunday, February 26, 2012, starting at 12:30 PM and ending at 2:00 PM (PT), prior to the final pageant competition. Voting will take place at the main entrance to the venue where the final pageant is being held. Votes will be counted and added to the total votes from the online voting.
5. Voters may vote for as many contestants as they choose and as many times as they choose.
6. One vote equals \$1.00 (US dollar) donation.
7. Voters must vote a minimum of five (5) votes or \$5.00 US dollars for any given contestant.
8. Percentages of all donations will be distributed accordingly: Seventy percent to be used for the Mrs. Nevada-America & Nevada Princess Pageant educational scholarship and other associated costs/fees; Thirty percent to benefit Project Teddy.
9. No refunds will be issued to any voter for any reason, under no circumstances.
10. There will be one winner among all contestants combined from each age division. The winner will be announced on February 26, 2012 during the final pageant competition.
11. If for any reason there is a tie, the contestant with the highest Judges Interview score will become the People's Choice winner.
12. Winner will receive the following prizes: *Model of the Year* title, a fabulous photo shoot and special web page devoted just to her on the state pageant website. She will also win the opportunity to attend FUSION Model & Talent search to be held **June 23rd and 24th, 2012** at Planet Hollywood Resort, Las Vegas. Prizes are non-exchangeable not redeemable for cash.
